MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SCREENING COMMITTEE FOR CONSIDERATION OF ELIGIBLE PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR FOCUSED INTERVENTION PROGRAMMES (ODIC & CPLI) IN SELECTED DISTRICTS UNDER THE NATIONAL ACTION PLAN FOR DRUG DEMAND REDUCTION (NAPDDR) HELD ON 24th SEPTEMBER, 2020.

Meeting of the Screening Committee, constituted by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, was held on 24th September, 2020 under the Chairpersonship of Ms. B. Radhika Chakravarthy, Joint Secretary (Social Defence) to consider the new proposals of ODIC & CPLI, invited from VOs/NGOs for focused intervention programmes in selected districts under the National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR).

Shri S. Prakash, Member of the Committee could not be present during the meeting.

Screening committee quorum was fulfilled.

- 3. The Joint Secretary (Social Defence) and Chairperson informed the Committee that the Ministry proposes to undertake Focussed Intervention Programmes in 272 selected districts, across the Country under the NAPDDR by setting up of Community Based Peer Led Intervention Centres (CPLIs) and Outreach and Drop in Centres (ODICs). The aim is to reach adolescents and youth in the community and to increase community participation as well as public cooperation in the reduction of demand for dependence-producing substances and also to encourage youth dependent on drugs to come forward for treatment in safe and secure environment.
- 4. Members were also briefed that out of total number of proposals of ODICs and CPLIs received in the Ministry, 218 proposals which have been found complete and eligible for consideration of the Screening Committee in accordance with the criteria prescribed under the scheme of NAPDDR.
- 5. It was also informed to all the members that the eligible proposals were forwarded to the concerned State Governments for their recommendations based on grading formula. As per the grading, there were maximum 100 points, out of which 40 marks for IRCA/de-addiction performance and number of beneficiaries benefited during previous

years, 15 marks for research and development activity, 15 marks for award from Central Government or State Government in the field of prevention of drug and substance use, 10 marks for having their own website, 10 marks for solely concentrating on drugs de-addiction and 10 marks for funds generated from other sources.

- Screening Committee scrutinised all the proposals placed before it with 6 reference to prescribed criteria viz. valid registration certificate, de-addiction activities in MoA, performance of NGOs in the field of de-addiction, scrutiny of Annual reports & Audit reports of the last three years. The Committee also scrutinised the proposals with reference to PMU/State reports, clean & clear records, complaints, if any, recommendation of the State, whether rainbow organization or working only in area of drugs prevention and awareness etc. Grading based performance report was obtained from the concerned State Governments in respect of eligible proposals. Based on the recommendations received and grading given by the State Governments, scrutinizing the performance of the NGOs in the field of de-addiction and as per the eligibility criteria provided in scheme guidelines of NAPDDR, the Committee recommended 42 Proposals (23 ODIC at Annexure-I and 19 CPLI at Annexure-II) subject to satisfactory physical inspection reports of these centres by Ministry's officers/ SLCAs /PMU State Coordinators and cross verification with the list of blacklisted NGOs from NACO.
- 7. The proposals of the States of **Bihar and Goa** were not recommended by the Screening Committee, as the concerned State Governments have not recommended their eligible proposals, as the centres were either closed or non-existent.
- 8. The proposals of **Jharkhand**, without recommendation from the State Government, were also placed before the Screening Committee. The Committee observed that all these proposals submitted by the organisations for the State were based outside the State. Accordingly, Committee has not recommended these proposals for the State of Jharkhand.
- 9. Representative of the State of **Manipur** informed that meeting notice and list of proposals was received by them only on the day prior to the Screening Committee Meeting, therefore State could not provide recommendations and sought some more time for inspection/ field visit of these centres. The Committee had informed the representative of Manipur that the intimation and list of proposals were sent to the State well in advance and also reminded to submit their report. State of Manipur is to look into the veracity of the stand taken by them about the receipt of proposals and Meeting Notice one day prior stated by them. However, as requested by the representative of Manipur, the Committee asked the Government of Manipur to send the report, weightage and recommendation regarding proposals forwarded to them within a week.
- 10. Representative of **Government of Tamil Nadu** informed that due to technical problems, most of the NGOs experienced difficulties in submitting their online application on e-Anudaan, despite making several attempts. The Government of Tamil

Nadu has not recommended any of the proposals. Therefore, Screening Committee has not recommended any proposals of Tamil Nadu.

- 11. Representative of **Uttar Pradesh** has requested for more time, as they could not complete inspection of the organizations. They have also requested to be provided complete address, e-mail and phone/ mobile number of the organizations. The Committee directed to provide the complete details of the eligible proposals to the Government of Uttar Pradesh for forwarding of inspection as well as performance report to this Ministry within 15 days given the huge number of proposals.
- 12. Eligible proposals of the State of **West Bengal** were also considered by the Screening Committee, however it was noted that the performance of the eligible organisations were found to be far from satisfactory by the PMU State Coordinator. Accordingly, the Committee did not recommend the proposals of the State of West Bengal.
- 13. Eligible Proposals of the State Governments of Chhattisgarh, Karnataka and Telangana have not been considered by the Screening Committee as none of the respective State Governments have sent their comments or participated in the meeting. Accordingly, proposals of these States have not been recommended by the Committee.
- 14. Recommendations of the Committee as above are subject to satisfactory physical inspection report by the officers of the Ministry/ PMU/ SLCA and compliance of conditions, completion of necessary formalities under the revised Scheme of NAPDDR w.e.f. 01.04.2020 and cross verification with the list of blacklisted NGOs from NACO.
